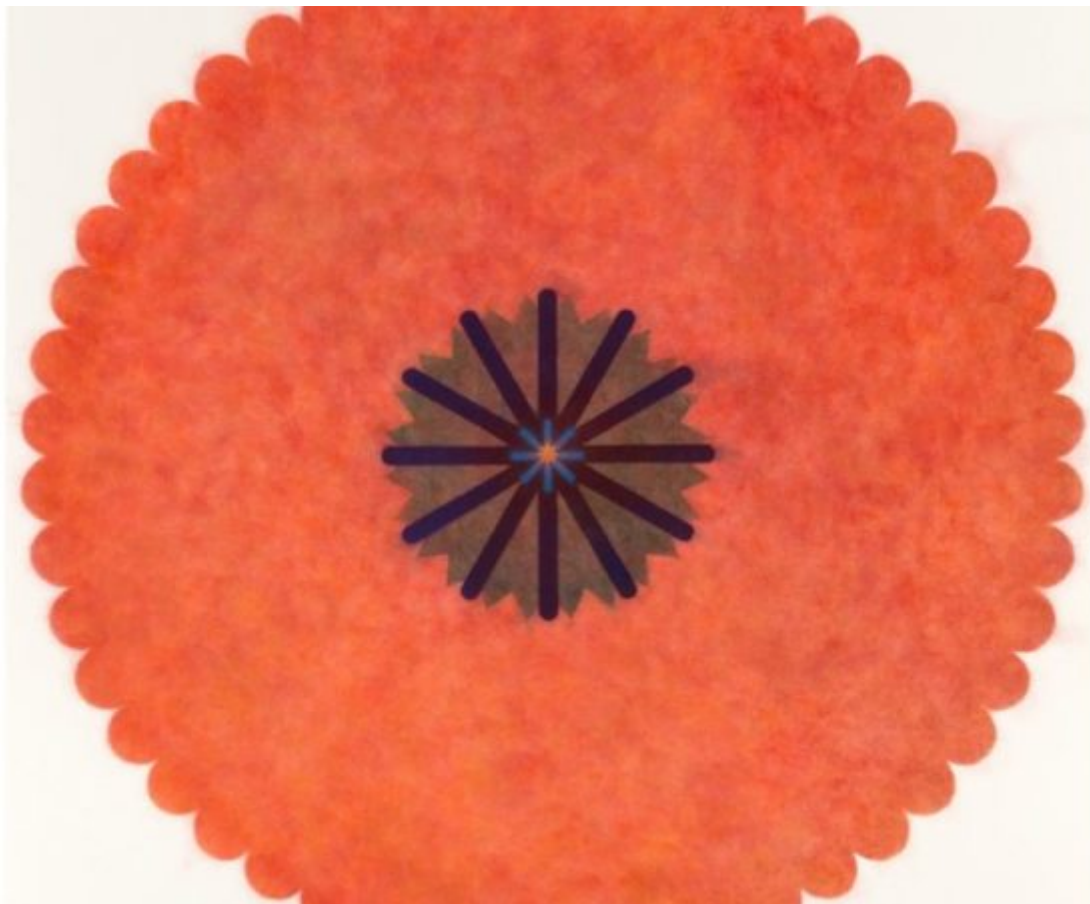


Coming Up: 'Polypetalous' Exhibit in Larchmont, Opens Nov. 5

'Polypetalous,' as in many "Pop Flowers," is a new show coming to Kenise Barnes Fine Art (<http://www.kbfa.com>) in Larchmont. The images add new meaning to the botanical notion of many separate petals on flowers and are extremely beautiful.
