Winter White: The Absence of Color

Curated by Katharine Dufault, *Winter White: The Absence of Color* will present the work of 15 artists whose use of white defines and unifies the work.

“Using a variety of different media and within the confines of the monochromatic palette, color is no longer the concern; rather texture, pattern, and shadow fall into play. White is produced when all the color wavelengths of visible light are reflected without absorption (the opposite of black which absorbs all light without reflection). By complementing January’s winter palette of bleak skies and snow, the work will set forth a

binary relationship between interior and exterior, artificial and organic, man-made and natural.” says Dufault.

Participating artists are Kate Doyle, Katharine Dufault, Roxanne Faber-Savage, David Fox, Irving Harper, Arnold Kastenbaum, Alexandra Kohl, David Licata, Henry Mandell, Patricia Miranda, Lael Morgan, Ira Richer, B. Avery Syrig, Priya Tambe, and Barbara Weiss.

The artists are established and emerging and work in a variety of two and three dimensional media including: paint, encaustic, photography, glass, wood, plaster, fiber, and a site-specific interactive installation.

Winter White: The Absence of Color will include a piece by the late artist and designer Irving Harper, whose spectacular paper sculptures were exhibited in a solo show at The Rye Arts Center last year.

All are invited to enjoy a **free opening reception: Saturday, January 30, 3 - 5 pm** at The Rye Arts Center (51 Milton Road, Rye, NY). There will be a live musical performance by DueFunk.

This is first time that The Rye Arts Center will present an exhibition of work that has been chosen based on a single color, or absence thereof, in this case: White.

The exhibition will be on view January 23 - March 5. Gallery Hours: Monday: 9 am - 3 pm, Tuesday - Friday: 9 am - 5 pm, Saturday: 9 am - 3 pm, Sunday: Closed.


