Josette Urso: 'Snow Day' (closes on Saturday) Contrary to the show's title, the strongest of these lush abstractions are the ones in which the drifts and banks of brilliant white oil paint are the least obtrusive or disappear altogether. In them the artist's propensity for weaving, noodling and circling — as well as generally messing wet-on-wet color into subtly crazed patchworks of contrasting patterns, textures and pictorial ideas — takes over.
