Walk barefoot along the Stria carpet, and you'll literally feel each hue. Hand-tufted, caramel-coloured New Zealand wool steps down to bright coral carved cotton, then further still to pool blue wool. The back-and-forth of material and pigment plays along the length of the rug. Watson Soule translates the texture of canvas-bound paintings into functional art.
