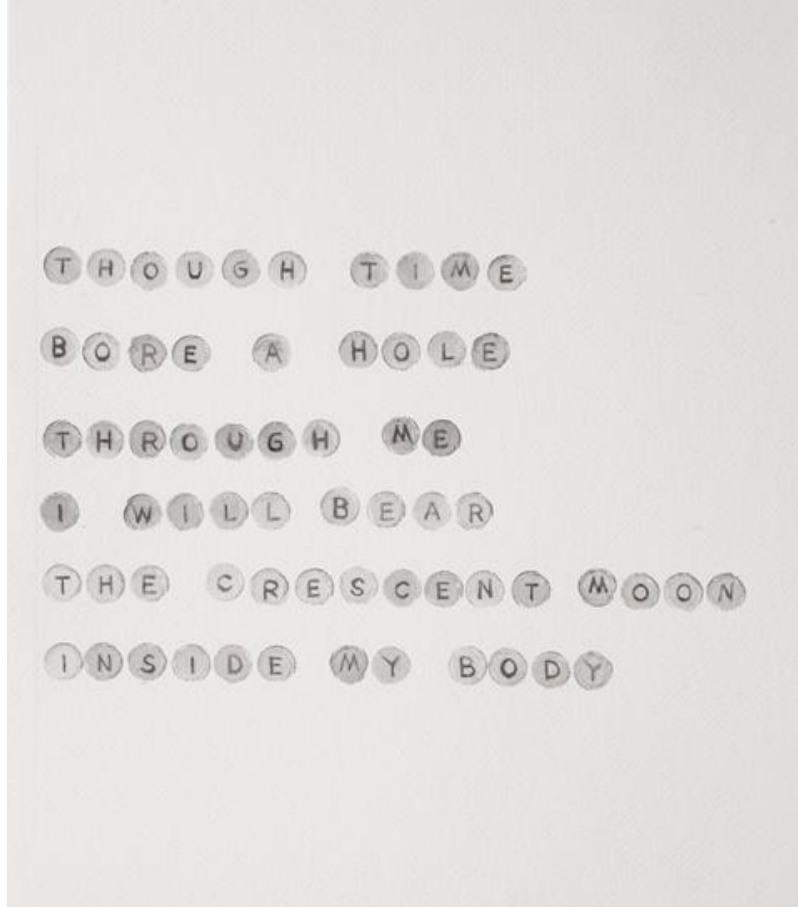
Thank you Hupstate circus artists!
